



## Ivermectin helped my husband and me

I am a hospice nurse in East Texas who takes care of all types of terminally ill and actively dying patients, including COVID patients. In late August I began to feel ill while at work. By the next morning my temp was 103 F and I was coughing persistently, very aware I had COVID and had brought it home. My husband and I both became sick. We went to our PCP's urgent care and were diagnosed with COVID. When I asked the PA his protocol, he LAUGHED at me and asked if I had Tylenol and cough syrup! He sent us home with NOTHING, no treatment at all, and with instructions to go to the ER when our lips turned blue.

I had ivermectin in house for an emergency for us and 1 week before this my PCP messaged me to inform me she would no longer fill my Ivermectin Rx "due to ethical reasons". We didn't have enough ivermectin for both of us and we had to share. We got a prescription for ivermectin from another doctor. The local pharmacies told me none of them had any Ivermectin but I finally located some. My husband felt better in two days. I ended up with Long-Haul COVID and am still taking ivermectin as I recover. I am following the I-RECOVER protocol.
