Responsibilities

- Help create policies and procedures for backup and restoration of WordPress systems, including to new hosting platforms.
- Help create eCommerce solutions with multiple payment processor fallbacks.
- Performance tune new and existing systems to ensure fast response time and scalability.
- Secure systems against multiple potential attack vectors.

Qualifications

Not all qualifications will be expected.

- (required) High competency in modern WordPress systems (hosting, themes, plugins, configuration, etc.)
- (required) Modern PHP competency, particularly in context of custom WordPress development.
- (required) Competency in HTML5 (DOM, CSS3, etc.).
- (required) Competency in MySQL, especially in the context of WordPress schemas and data
- (highly recommended) Familiarity with a variety of hosting platforms and solutions
- (recommended) Familiarity with Avada/Fusion builder (deep understanding is big bonus)
- (recommended) Competency in performance and security: caching, CDNs, DDOS, common attack patterns and prevention, analysis tools (such as New Relic), etc.
- (bonus points, but not required) Capable design and UX skills for bringing new features to final polish stages

- (bonus points, not required) Familiarity with Agile processes and Jira.
