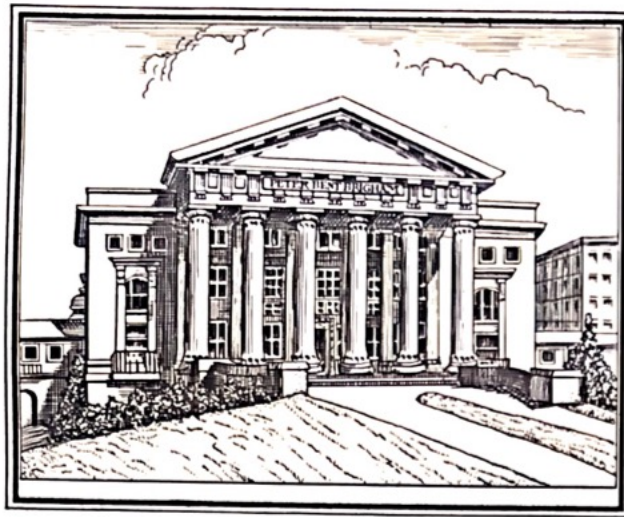

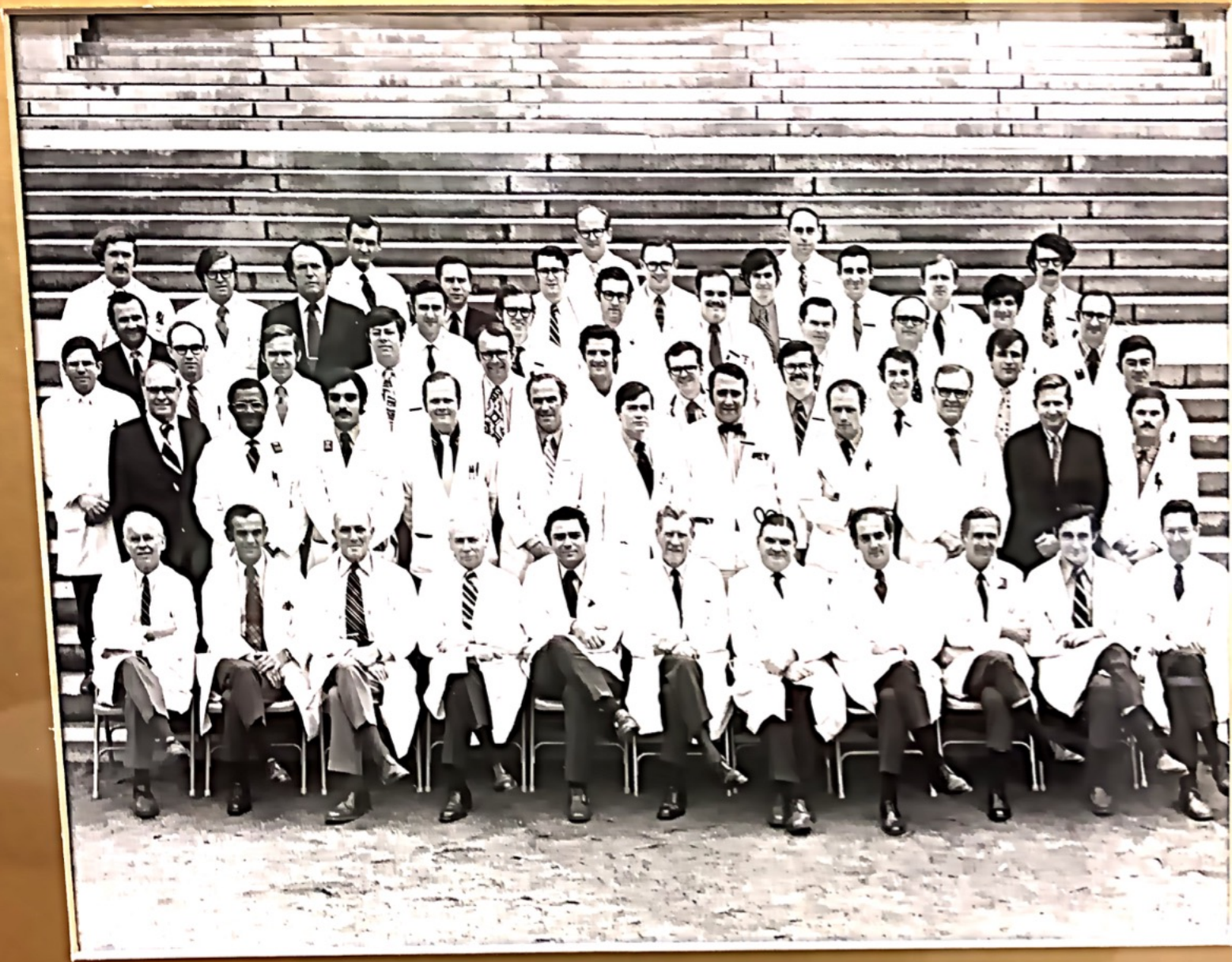

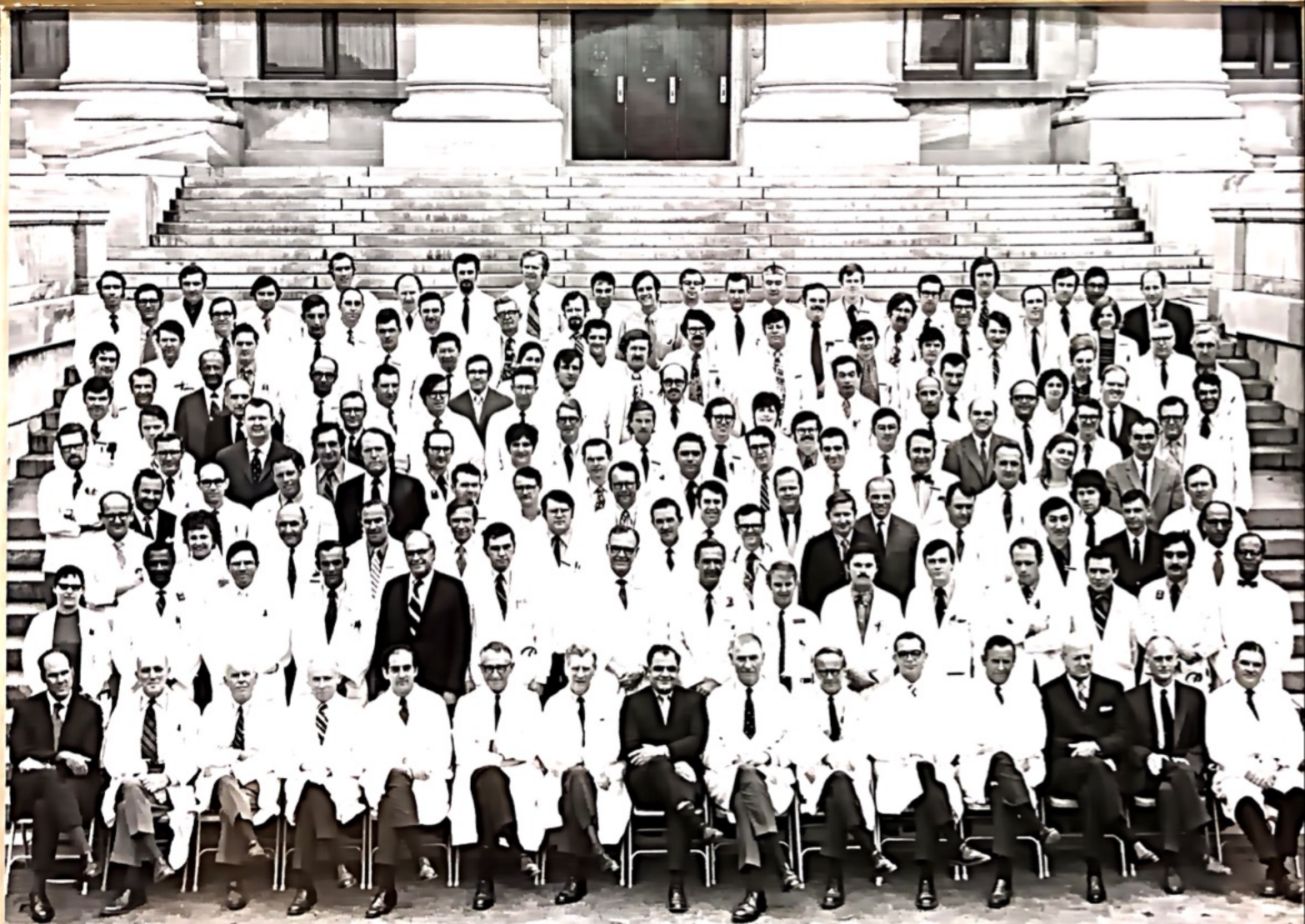

Know Ye, that reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity and abilities of GEORGE C. FAREED *I do appoint* him a Commissioned Officer *in the Reserve Corps of the*

Public Health Service
U.S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare

Effective the sixth *day of* January *, nineteen hundred and* seventy-one *. This Officer will therefore carefully and diligently discharge the duties of the office to which appointed by doing and performing all manner of things thereunto belonging.*

And I do strictly charge and require those Officers and other personnel of lesser rank to render such obedience as is due an officer of this grade and position. And this Officer is to observe and follow such orders and directions, from time to time, as may be given by me, or the future President of the United States of America, or other Superior Officers acting in accordance with the laws of the United States of America.

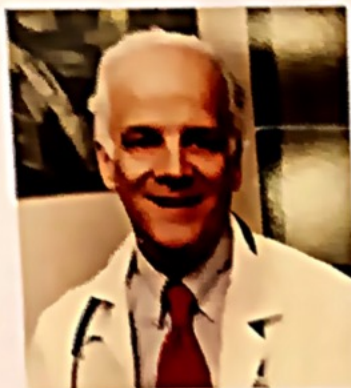
